IN BRIEF: Caribbean bill clears US lower house

The US House of Representatives overwhelmingly approved a bill earlier this week that directs the Department of State to submit to Congress a multi-year strategy for US engagement with the Caribbean region.

"The strategy will lay out plans to support the Caribbean in improving energy security, strengthening the rule of law, reducing drug trafficking, and enhancing economic cooperation," said representative Eliot Engel (D-NY), who sponsored the bill, at the Inter-American Development Bank and Caribbean-Central American Action forum.

The legislative initiative comes amid a planned increase of US energy exports to the region – led by natural gas – as US liquefaction plants come online, and improved US-Cuba relations.
